

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority under the "Travel and Transportation Reform Act of 1998"

The Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller) (USD(C)) is hereby delegated the authority of the Secretary of Defense under the "Travel and Transportation Reform Act of 1998" (TTRA), Public Law 105-264. The USD(C) shall issue such instructions as necessary to implement the Act within the Department, which may provide for such review and approval of DoD Component's implementation of the TTRA as the USD(C) deems appropriate.

The authority delegated by this memorandum may be redelegated in writing by the USD(C) to the heads of the DoD Components.

Because of the importance of this Act to all DoD personnel and organizations, I ask that you cooperate with the USD(C) to ensure that the Act is implemented consistently and fairly throughout the Department.
