



Business Enterprise Architecture

Enterprise Architecture

An enterprise architecture is a combined view of operational (information and work functions), technical (standards and constraints), and supporting systems capabilities needed to perform a mission. Gaps between the existing and targeted capabilities create a “blueprint” for building and connecting new and existing processes and systems. The architecture for the BMMP is called the Business Enterprise Architecture, or BEA.

Implementing the Architecture

Implementing the BEA requires the cooperation, expertise, and collaboration of DoD's primary business owners. Leaders of these business lines, or “domains,” define content for the architecture and implement modernization and business transformation in compliance with the blueprint. These business lines uniformly support all DoD military operations.

DoD has appointed a Domain “owner” for each business area who is responsible for managing the business transformation within the laws, policies, regulations, and business practices and rules defined within the enterprise architecture.

How Big is BMMP?

BMMP impacts:

- 5.4 Million employees, service members, and beneficiaries
 - Paychecks and W-2's
 - Personnel records and actions
 - Medical and Dental records, appointments, admissions, and discharges
 - Training records, plans, and scheduling classes
 - Travel requests, tickets, and vouchers
- \$400 Billion+ /Year
 - 267 Appropriations
 - 124 Million accounting transactions
 - 11.2 Million invoices
- \$700 Billion+ in Assets
- 600,000 Buildings at 6,000 locations in 146 Countries
 - Treaties, Local Laws, and Regulations
 - Leasing arrangements
 - Security
 - Environmental liabilities
 - Real property inventories
- 1,312 Major weapons systems
 - 4.6 Million parts and supplies managed
- 150+ Federal Source Laws and Regulations (Ex. Title 5, 10, 32, 37)
 - 4,200+ Specific requirements from source laws
- 2,274 Systems... and Counting
 - Different standards and interpretations of rules and requirements
