BMMP Governance

Governance describes how and by whom business transformation will be implemented within the Department.


BMMP Governance:

- provides organizational structure and performance measurement, which define boundaries, authorities, responsibilities, and tasks
- ensures efficient execution, guidance, and oversight for compliance
- aligns the acquisition, planning / budgeting, implementation, and evaluation of all DoDBusiness systems with the Department's strategic direction.

The Business Mission Area

Business transformation requires processes that transcend current organizational boundaries. Extensive coordination across DoD Components (Military Departments, Defense Agencies, and DoD Field Activities) is absolutely essential. BMMP governance includes the Business Modernization and Systems Integration (BMSI) program office, and six business domains working in concert with the Enterprise Information Environment Mission Area. Business domains integrate transformation needs and requirements with the military departments, defense agencies and other domain owners to integrate cross domain issues. Through integrated governance DoD will ensure our business processes and systems work together.

How Big is BMMP?

BMMP impacts:

- 5.4M employees, service members and beneficiaries
 - Paychecks and W-2's
 - Personnel records and actions
 - Medical and Dental records, appointments, admissions and discharges
 - Training records, plans, and scheduling classes
 - Travel requests, tickets, vouchers
- \$400B+ /Year
 - 267 Appropriations
 - 124 Million accounting transactions
 - 11.2 Million invoices
- \$700B+ in Assets
- 600,000 Buildings at 6,000 locations in 146 Countries
 - Treaties, Local Laws and Regulations
 - Leasing arrangements
 - Security
 - Environmental liabilities
 - Real property inventories
- 1,312 Major weapons systems
 - 4.6 Million parts and supplies managed
- 150+ Federal Source Laws and Regulations (Ex. Title 5, 10, 32, 37)
 - 4,200+ Specific requirements from source laws
- 2,274 Systems... and Counting
 - Different standards and interpretations of rules and requirements
