This internal reprogramming action consists of two parts: **Part I** transfers \$44.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 04/04, appropriation to the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 03/04, appropriation. **Part II** transfers \$44.0 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund, 03/04, appropriation to Other Procurement, Army, 04/06, appropriation. These funds were initially transferred from the IFF to Operation and Maintenance, Army, 04/04 in FY 04-03 IR. These funds should have been transferred to the Other Procurement, Army, 04/06, appropriation for proper execution. This transfer authority is contained in Public Law 108-11, the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2003. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were previously appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the items.
