

Timeline for FY 2018 DoD Legislative Program

| September- November 2016 | <i>Initial internal coordination of critical proposals</i> |
| Late January-Early February 2017 | <i>Target date for issuance of second call memo</i> |
| Mid-February 2017 | <i>Target date for submission of proposals by DoD components to OLC in response to second call memo</i> |
| Early March 2017 | <i>Target date for initial submission of proposals to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for Administration coordination and clearance</i> |
| May 2017 | <i>Target date for initial transmission of proposals to Congress</i> |

The above timeline is designed to provide components with a general outline of how the FY 2018 legislative cycle should proceed. However, aside from the August 15th date for the submission of critical proposals to OLC, all other dates are tentative and subject to change after new senior leadership arrives in 2017.
