SUBJECT: Request for Equipment Support for Waco Operation

1. On 25 March 93 the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) requested the immediate loan of 12 M1009 vehicles and two trucks (2 & 1/2 or 5-ton) with tarps and drivers. They have confirmed that no commercially suitable vehicles are available in the local area. The M1009s will be used for off-road patrolling and perimeter security for the on-going operation in Waco, Texas. The two trucks will be used for a possible contingency operation by the ATF in Waco.

2. Upon DOD approval, the Texas National Guard will provide this support. Military markings will be obscured. Appropriate maintenance slice is already on hand; no additional personnel are needed to maintain trucks. ATF agents will operate the M1009 vehicles and National Guard personnel will operate the two trucks; they will not participate in any aspect of civil law enforcement and will be restricted to operations in safe and secure areas.

3. A standard DOD loan agreement will be completed prior to receipt of the equipment to the ATF and under the provisions of the Economy Act the Army will be reimbursed for all use. The ATF will also pay maintenance personnel per diem and all other identifiable direct and indirect costs. ATF point of contact to coordinate loan and for reimbursement instructions is DOD liaison officer, [redacted] (202 927-8020). The duration of this loan is indefinite (until completion of operations in Waco) but will not exceed one year.

4. These actions are authorized under the provisions of the Economy Act and were coordinated with the National Guard Bureau [redacted], OSAGC [redacted] ODCSLOG [redacted] OSD-ES [redacted] and ASA(IL&E) [redacted].



SUBJECT: Loan of Texas National Guard Equipment to U.S. Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (ATF)

1. Today, [REDACTED] received a request for assistance from [REDACTED] OGC-Army, to review a request by the ATF to the DOMS for 12 M1009 (CUT-V) vehicles and two 5-ton/2.5-T trucks to support the ongoing operation in Waco, Texas against the Davidian cult. The ATF states that it will reimburse DoD under the provisions of the Economy Act for all costs associated with the loan of equipment. Under the circumstances provided by ATF and DAMO-ODS [REDACTED], loan of the equipment to the ATF is permissible. SECARMY is the approval authority. DAMO-ODS must follow the procedures for loan of DoD equipment to Federal civilian law enforcement authorities detailed in Chapter 2, AR 700-131.

2. A previous request for this equipment was denied; HQDA told ATF to secure this equipment through commercial sources. ATF rented two commercial 4-wheel drive vehicles, but avers that no more are reasonably available.

3. Applicable references are DODD 5525.5 (DoD Cooperation with Civilian Law Enforcement Officials), Enclosure 3, and AR 700-131 (Loan and Lease of Army Materiel), Chapter 2.

4. The Texas National Guard will provide drivers for the 5-ton/2.5-ton trucks. Texas National Guard personnel are activated in a Title 32, Section 112 (counterdrug) status (the ATF was investigating the Davidian cult for drugs, also). ATF personnel will operate the M1009's. Maintenance personnel already are available on site from previous requests for support. The Texas AG, National Guard Bureau, and DCSLOG are aware of the request.

5. DODD 5525.5, Enclosure 3, paragraph D.3.c., outlines approval authority for loans to Federal civilian law enforcement officials under the Economy Act. Requests for arms, ammunition, combat vehicles, vessels, and aircraft are subject to approval by the SECARMY. A notice of approval or denial shall be reported to the ASD(FM&P) within 48 hours after such action. Loan or lease of other equipment may be approved by the SECARMY or his designee under rules promulgated by DA (AR 700-131). ASD(FM&P) requires notice if such other equipment is loaned for more than 60 days.

6. AR 700-131, paragraph 2-3, provides Federal activities receiving loans of DoD equipment are responsible for reimbursing

SUBJECT: Loan of Texas National Guard Equipment to U.S. Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) costs are contained in

DoD for all DoD costs incident to the delivery, return, and repair of the materiel. Additionally, the borrower is responsible for reimbursing DoD for the full purchase price for consumable or nondurable items (such as batteries) and for depreciation if the depreciation cost is significant. Applicable costs are outlined in Chapter 5, AR 700-131. Arms, ammunition, combat vehicles, vessels, and aircraft are approved by the SECARMY of his designee (DOMS). We assumed that these military vehicles are "combat vehicles." [If they are not combat vehicles, the Texas AG is the approval authority, para 2c, AR 700-131.] Loan agreement procedures are outlined in paragraph 2-6; actions by the approving authority and loaning activity are detailed in paragraphs 2-12 and 2-13, respectively.

7. Requests for use of ARNG equipment which require HQDA approval/action will be routed through the National Guard Bureau (para 2-10b, AR 700-131).

8. Texas National Guard personnel do not fall within the restrictions on DoD personnel participating in civilian law enforcement activities contained in Enclosure 4, DODD 5525.5 (para B.2).
