Reuben,

The penalties in Section 6 for antiaircraft missiles, RPGs and improvised explosive devices would seem to be much too mild. Given the potential consequences of the use of such weapons – and the lack of any other reason for people to have them – a mandatory sentence of life imprisonment would not be disproportionate, particularly for surface-to-air missiles.

Moreover, those weapons which are essentially anti-Coalition or terrorist weapons should be distinguished from other “heavy weapons,” which are a problem, but not of the same kind.
