Dear Mr. Hoover:

This Office has for consideration the access authorization case of Jeremy Judah STONE (Born: 25 November 1935, New York, New York) and Betty Jane STONE (Born: 31 August 1935, New Haven, Connecticut), both employees of the Rand Corporation, Santa Monica, California. The case file contains an FBI investigative report on the father of Jeremy Judah Stone, Isidor Feinstein Stone (File No. WFO 100-22286, Bureau 100-37078).

In order to assist us in the preparation of this case for an eventual personal appearance proceeding, it is requested that you furnish the following information about the various confidential informants utilized in the report:

Which, if any, of the following informants are available and willing to testify at a personal appearance proceeding: WFT-1 through WFT-37. Please furnish the complete identity and address of each informant who is available and willing to testify together with any pertinent information you may have indicating the potential worth of each as a witness.

On the other hand, in the cases of those informants who are either unavailable or unwilling to testify, please advise in each case the reasons therefor, and furnish an assessment of the reliability of each.

It appears quite probable that the testimony of all the above informants will not be necessary to establish the proof desired, but in the absence of information as to the availability and willingness to appear of any specified informant it seems the only logical procedure is to request information concerning all of them. When it becomes apparent that informants having knowledge relating to key issues are available and willing to testify, it will not be necessary to contact others whose information duplicates that already obtained.

Your assistance in this matter will be greatly appreciated.
