Note 1: **Data Code** may contain from 1 to 9 significant characters, depending on which data element code set is searched. **SCT Table ID** identifies the corresponding data element type:

- AG – Agency with Subelement (See Note 3)
- AH – Agency without Subelement
- BA – Leo Geographic Pay Area (01/1994 – 04/2004)
- BD – Functional Class
- BX – Pay Status
- EM – Rating Of Record Pattern (10/1996 – present)
- EV – Educational Level
- FE – Legal Authority
- GF – Occupational Category
- JA – CBSA (Core Based Statistical Area) (01/2005 – present; generated for older files)
- JY – Consolidated MSA (03/1991 – 12/2004)
- KW – Special Pay Table ID (03/1991 – present)
- LA – Pay Plan

Note 2: Most code sets (identified by SCT Table ID) use a Data Code validity date range to identify the time frame in which the code is/was valid for CPDF submissions. A value of “999999” in the Date Code in Use Until element indicates the code is currently valid. For a retrieved Data Code to be valid, the associated search date must be greater than or equal to an occurrence of Date Code in Use From and must be less than the corresponding occurrence of Date Code in Use Until.

Translations use similar validity dates to identify the time period a particular translation is valid. The most recent translation is in Translation 1, the previous translation is in Translation 2, etc.

The Date in use from/until values are zeros for these system-generated code sets that do not use Data Code validity date ranges: BA, BE, GF, JA, JY, LB, VM.

Instructional Program codes were converted from 4 to 6 characters in 1993 and have Date in Use From values beginning with 199310. The Instructional Program codes in historical Status and Dynamics files were all converted to the current 6-character structure.

Note 3: The “AG” group of codes includes both Agency and Subelement titles (i.e. Department of the Air Force, Air National Guard). Generally if the third and fourth position of the 4-character agency/subelement code are “00”, the code refers to an independent agency (OM00 = Office of Personnel Management). If those positions are spaces, the code refers to the main title of an agency or department that has additional subelements.

EXCEPTION: In August, 2011, the Department of Energy began submitting Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) records with agency/subelement code DNFE and all other non-FERC records with code DN00.

NOTE: The code for the US Tax Court changed from LT00 to JL03 in August 2013 to reflect a reassessment that it is a Judicial Branch agency rather than a Legislative Branch agency.

Note 4: **Duty Station** codes are composed of State code (pos 1-2), City code (pos 3-6), and County code (pos 7-9). Translations for States, Countries, and Territories will have zeros in

positions 3-9 of the Duty Station code (“010000000” = Alabama, “RQ0000000” = Puerto Rico). Translations for Counties will have zeros in positions 3-6 (“010000019” = Cherokee County, Alabama, “480000113” is Dallas County, Texas). Translations for Cities in the U.S. will have non-zero values in all three components of the Duty Station code (“011730089” is Huntsville, Alabama).

Note 5: **Agency-dependent Bargaining Unit** codes use two components to identify translations. The first four positions of Data Code may contain an agency/subelement code, an agency code, or “*****” indicating the code applies government-wide. Positions 5-8 contain the Bargaining Unit codes identifying the organization representing a particular group of employees; this is the value that will be contained in individual employee records. The following are example valid SCT Bargaining Unit Data Codes and translations:

Note 6: **Step/Rate** codes use three components to identify translations for employees with Pay Plan AL and Grade 03 only. The first two positions of Data Code contain “AL”, the next two contain “03”, and positions 5-6 contain the Step value as used in individual Status or Dynamics records. The following are valid Step/Rate Data Codes and translations:

Note 7: **Grade** codes use two components to identify translations for employees with non-numeric grades in Pay Plans AL, AF, FA, FE, FP, GG, and TP. The first two positions of Data Code contain the pay plan code and positions 3-4 contain the Grade value as used in individual Status or Dynamics records. The following are example valid Grade Data Codes and translations:
